French Expectations

In a lesson

At the beginning of the lesson go over and reinforce the Redeemer mantra for French

“In French we have fun learning how to communicate in a different language and learn about cultures different to ours”

Each lesson will begin with a recap of prior learning

The objective for the new learning and main content of the lesson should be shared and made clear to the children. Links/Reference may be made to the end product at the end of the unit e.g. what the children are working towards.

The main part of the lesson will be spent on the following: acquisition of new vocabulary; French phonics; speaking or listening activities; reading activity or a writing activity.

Where appropriate the reading activity will be linked to a book. The acquisition and reinforcement of vocabulary may be through the medium of a game, song or role play situations.

The vast majority of a French lesson should be interactive, either between the teacher and the children or between the children.
