SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

As a two-form entry school, each year group at The Redeemer is split into two classes of 30 pupils. This close-knit arrangement allows for strong collaboration between the classes, fostering enhanced social skills and awareness as children interact with a wider peer group. Our structure provides a well-rounded environment where pupils learn to build lasting friendships and develop confidence within their year group.

Each of our classrooms has its own external door, allowing parents the opportunity to drop off and pick up their children directly from their class teachers. This design strengthens the bond between home and school from the very start of your child's journey with us, ensuring clear, consistent communication.

We further nurture these home-school relationships through a variety of events where parents are warmly invited to participate. These include parental workshops, open afternoons where you can tour the school and admire your child's work, Friday Celebration Worships, Parents' Evenings, and Christmas and Easter services, among other occasions. These moments provide invaluable opportunities to engage with your child's learning and connect with the school community.
