Culture Clash	Some cultures can 'clash' when they believe different things. However, it is important to show our British values on these occasions.	
Ethnocentrism	The belief that your culture is superior to someone else's.	
Prohibited	Something that is forbidden/banned.	
Tension	When something is under a lot of strain.	
Compatible	When two things can work together without problems or conflict.	
Incompatible	When two things cannot work together without problems or conflict.	
Fundamental British Values		
Democracy	Everyone has rights and responsibilities	
Mutual Respect and Tolerance	It is important to understand we do not all share the same belief but we should respect the ideas, values and beliefs on others providing they are compatible with British law	
Rule of Law	Rules give everyone a safe, happy and secure place to live and work	
Individual Liberty	Everyone has rights and we should respect others just as we protect our own
